9. Regulations

The tasks set each day will include all known departure, turn point and finish procedures supported by LX Navigation instruments. Daily AATs with large sectors will be flown to allow the pilots to adapt the distance to their experience and glider type.

It is possible that more than one pilot flies the same glider.

For flight validation **IGC approved** flight recorders are mandatory.

Pilots are obliged to respect local airspace and altitude restrictions.

Every pilot must follow IGC rules and regulation.

Hungarian handicap index will be respected.

10. Documents

All gliders should be regularly insured corresponding to the Hungarian rules (third part insurance 750.000,00 SDR / glider).

The pilots should own valid licenses and should be trained for cross-county flights.

ARC of the glider should be valid until May 6th 2019 at least.

11. Contest Number

The rules concerning the visibility of contest numbers will be strictly observed. If two contest numbers are identical or easily confused (e.g. "India, India" and "one, one") the competitors will be asked to change it based on their agreement.

12. Rental of gliders

13. Other conditions:
